

# COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

The Golden Civic Foundation invested \$243,732 in grants into the Golden community via four main areas: Community Grants, Special Grants, COVID-19 Community Relief Grants and Critical Needs Support. The grants, which were awarded from April 2020 through April 2021, were provided to 40 different Golden-based non-profit organizations that provide social, civic, cultural and education-based services to Golden residents. Important to note is that more than half of our grants were funded by the proceeds raised at our 2020 Gala.
