How does the organization support student engagement, learning culture, and academic achievement for our community's future generations? How does the organization make a significant, sustainable difference, now or in the future for Golden's community members? Scoring: More connection is preferred.</i></p>	20

How would the grant support the mission of the Foundation "For the Good of Golden"? <i>Example: How do the funds support the Foundation's mission to "For the Good of Golden" by supporting Golden's schools, cultural, social services, clubs and civic organizations? Scoring: More support is preferred.</i></p>	20
